Victoria is a beautiful, successful, upper-middle class lawyer; but very unsatisfied with her life. It all changes when she meets Fat Girl, a rap singer that becomes her client. Although at first Victoria despises him because of her own inner prejudices, she discovers a human being that, opposite to her, enjoys his life and follows his dreams.



Victoria is the first feature film directed by Coraly Santaliz. Starting on the ground floor in 1996 as a food server, she quickly moved up to assistant director and production coordinator on television commercials and feature films. Two of these projects went on to win prizes and recognition at several international Film Festivals. She made her directorial debut on the Music video for the Puertorican band: "La experiencia de Toñito Cabanillas". In 1998, Santaliz took the plunge and came to California, enrolling in the Film Program at Chapman University. She has also worked on documentaries for Showtime and The Discovery Channel, among others. "The Spanish Temp", her second short film, was screened at several film festivals in the US. The script of her third shortfilm "El anillo", won first prize in the First Short Film Competition, sponsored by "The Film Foundation, Inc". She also won the award for outstanding young filmmaker in the Puerto Rico Women Film Festival. Currently, Santaliz lives in Puerto Rico where she works as a professional director/editor for TV Commercials, Music videos and TV Shows. She has also worked as a Script Supervisor and Production Coordinator for a few independent films.
